Watch the sun set, town lights sparkle, and enjoy refreshments, lounging, live music, and ceremonies.






STUNNING BALCONY VIEWS



LAYOUT OPTIONS

Outside of the art studio is a long hallway showcasing the Nevada Gallery which features a portion of our permanent art collection. This is a great space for catering, drink stations, and mingling.

Grandma Tootsie's dining table is also located at the end of this space for a small or extended serving area or gift table.

A piano alcove leads to the balcony offering space for a gift or cake table, musicians, or warm entrance to a balcony ceremony, bouquet toss, lounging, or photo opportunities.




FOUR FLOORS OF FINE ART & HISTORY




